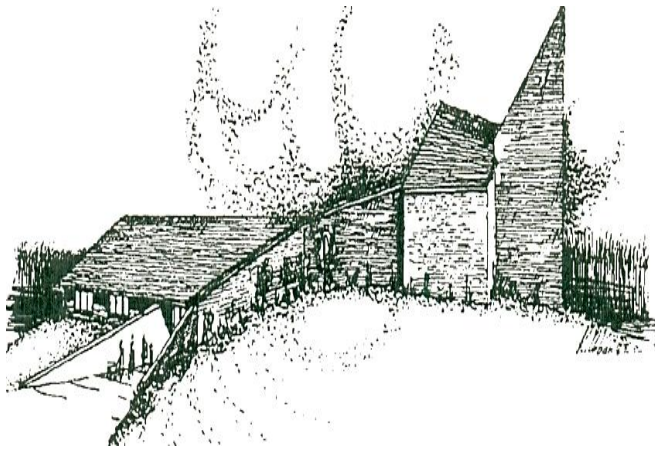

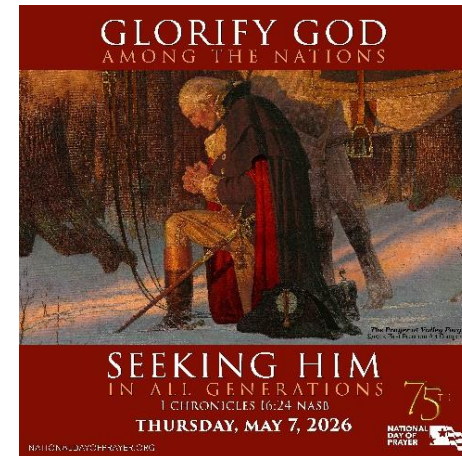
STAYING CONNECTED!
