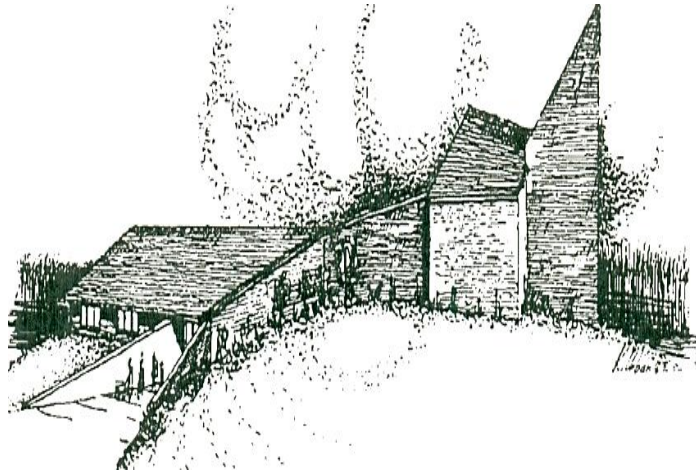

### SPEED LIMIT DRIVING SCHOOL

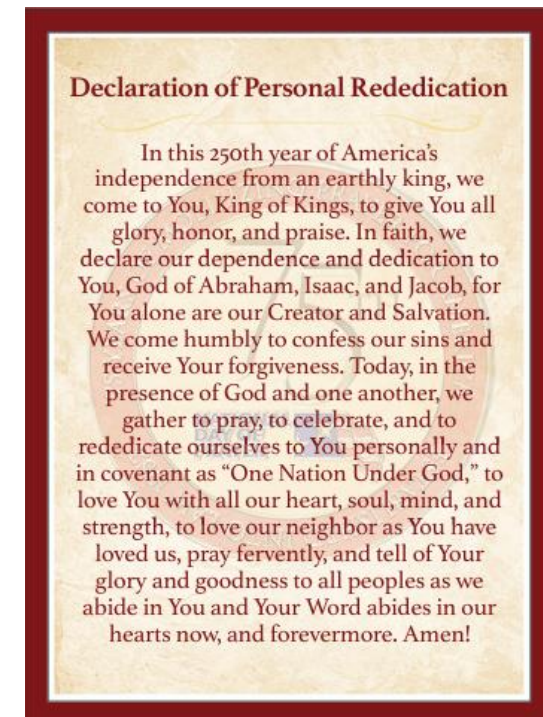
